## eINTERFACE'11 the 7<sup>th</sup> International Summer Workshop on Multimodal Interfaces Call for Project Proposals

University of West Bohemia, Faculty of Applied Sciences, Department of Cybernetics, invites project proposals for eINTERFACE'11, the 7<sup>th</sup> summer workshop on multimodal interfaces, which will be held in Plzeň, Czech Republic, from August 1st to August 26th, 2011. Following the success of the previous eINTERFACE workshops ([www.enterface.net](http://www.enterface.net)) held in Mons, Dubrovnik, Istanbul, Paris, Genova, and Amsterdam, eINTERFACE'11 aims at continuing and enhancing the tradition of collaborative, localized research and development work by gathering, in a single place, leading researchers in multimodal interfaces and students to work on specific projects for 4 complete weeks.

eINTERFACE'11 will encompass invited lectures and/or tutorials on several aspects of design of multimodal interfaces, given by invited senior researchers, and periodical presentations of the results achieved by each project group. The ultimate goal is to make this event a unique opportunity for students and experts all over the world to meet and effectively work together, so as to foster the development of tomorrow's multimodal research community. Project submissions on all themes below are welcome. We particularly encourage interdisciplinary proposals covering several themes and proposals integrating the OpenInterface and/or the EyesWeb XML platforms.

### Themes

- Multimodal signal analysis and synthesis
- Signal-level and meaning-level data fusion
- Multimodal conversational systems
- Intuitive interfaces and personalized systems in real and virtual environments
- User, context and semantics-aware self-learning and adapting systems
- Innovative modalities and modalities conversion
- Embodied agents
- Applications of Multimodal interfaces

### Deadlines:

December 17 <sup>th</sup> , 2010	Reception of a 1 page Notification of Interest, with a summary of project goals, work-packages, and deliverables
January 28 <sup>th</sup> , 2011	Reception of the complete project proposal in the format provided by the Author's kit
February 18 <sup>th</sup> , 2011	Notification of project acceptance, publication of the Call for Participation
April 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2011	Closing of the Call for Participation
April 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2011	Publication of teams
August 1 <sup>st</sup> – August 26 <sup>th</sup>	eINTERFACE'11 Workshop

Proposals should be submitted in PDF format to [e11@kky.zcu.cz](mailto:e11@kky.zcu.cz). It will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee with respect to suitability to the workshop goals and format. A call for PhD students and researchers participation will be then launched on February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Authors of the accepted proposals will then be invited to build their teams.
